

## **DIRECTIONS TO PITTSBURGH AND THE PITTSBURGH INSTITUTE OF PLASTIC SURGERY/PIPS (FRONT AND BACK)**

### **FROM THE NORTH**

#### **Via Interstate Route 279 South:**

Exit at the East Street Exit (Exit 8B) and proceed 0.4 mile to East Ohio Street (third traffic signal). Turn left onto East Ohio Street (PA Route 28 North) and proceed 0.2 mile to 16<sup>th</sup> Street (second traffic signal). Turn right onto 16<sup>th</sup> Street and proceed 0.6 mile to its termination at Liberty Avenue. Turn left onto Liberty Avenue and proceed 3.1 miles to its termination at Centre Avenue. Turn left onto Centre Avenue (which ultimately becomes Penn Circle South) and proceed 0.7 mile to 5989 Penn Circle South, a 1½ story yellow brick building, on the left. Park in the parking lot in front of (adjacent to) the building. Enter the entrance under the PIPS sign. The entrance to PIPS is to the right, after the entrance into the building.

#### **Via PA Route 28 South:**

Exit at the Highland Park Bridge Exit (Exit 6). Cross the Highland Park Bridge and exit at the Washington Boulevard Exit. Proceed along Washington Boulevard (PA Route 8 South) for 2.7 miles to Penn Avenue. Turn right onto Penn Avenue (do not continue to follow PA Route 8 South at this point) and proceed 0.7 mile, along the left/inside lane of Penn Avenue, to Penn Circle East. Cross Penn Circle East and proceed two blocks to Highland Avenue (first traffic signal after crossing Penn Circle East). Turn left onto (technically South) Highland Avenue and proceed two blocks to Penn Circle South (first traffic signal after turn onto Highland Avenue). Turn right onto Penn Circle South. Enter the first parking lot on the right (about 200 to 250 feet after turn onto Penn Circle South). Enter adjacent 1½ story yellow brick building via entrance under the PIPS sign. The entrance to PIPS is to the right, after the entrance into the building.

#### **Via PA Route 8 South:**

Exit at PA Route 28 North and follow PA Route 28 North to the Highland Park Bridge Exit (Exit 6). Exit at the Highland Park Bridge Exit (Exit 6), cross the Highland Park Bridge and exit at the Washington Boulevard Exit. Proceed along Washington Boulevard (a continuation of PA Route 8 South) for 2.7 miles to Penn Avenue. Turn right onto Penn Avenue (do not continue to follow PA Route 8 South at this point) and proceed 0.7 mile, along the left/inside lane of Penn Avenue, to Penn Circle East. Cross Penn Circle East and proceed two blocks to Highland Avenue (first traffic signal after crossing Penn Circle East). Turn left onto (technically South) Highland Avenue and proceed two blocks to Penn Circle South (first traffic signal after turn onto Highland Avenue). Turn right onto Penn Circle South. Enter the first parking lot on the right (about 200 to 250 feet after turn onto Penn Circle South). Enter adjacent 1½ story yellow brick building via entrance under the PIPS sign. The entrance to PIPS is to the right, after the entrance into the building.

### **FROM THE SOUTH**

#### **Via US Route 19 North and PA Routes 51 North and South:**

Follow to/through the Liberty Tunnels. Cross the Liberty Bridge and immediately thereafter exit at the Interstate 579 North Exit. Shortly thereafter exit at the PA Route 380 East (Bigelow Boulevard) Exit and proceed 1.0 mile to the Liberty Avenue/Bloomfield Exit. Exit at the Liberty Avenue/Bloomfield Exit and, at the end of the Bloomfield Bridge, turn right onto Liberty Avenue and proceed 1.0 mile to its termination at Centre Avenue. Turn left onto Centre Avenue (which ultimately becomes Penn Circle South) and proceed 0.7 mile to 5989 Penn Circle South, a 1½ story yellow brick building, on the left. Park in the parking lot in front of (adjacent to) the building. Enter the entrance under the PIPS sign. The entrance to PIPS is to the right, after the entrance into the building.

### **FROM THE EAST**

#### **Via Interstate Route 376 West and US Routes 22/30 West:**

Exit at the Edgewood/Swissvale Exit (Exit 7). At end of the exit ramp, turn right onto South Braddock Avenue and proceed 1.5 miles to Penn Avenue. Turn left onto Penn Avenue and proceed, along the left/inside lane of Penn Avenue, 1.8 miles to Penn Circle East. Cross Penn Circle East and proceed two blocks to Highland Avenue (first traffic signal after crossing Penn Circle East). Turn left onto (technically South) Highland Avenue and proceed two blocks to Penn Circle South (first traffic signal after turn onto Highland Avenue). Turn right onto Penn Circle South. Enter the first parking lot on the right (about 200 to 250 feet after turn onto Penn Circle South). Enter adjacent 1½ story yellow brick building via entrance under the PIPS sign. The entrance to PIPS is to the right, after the entrance into the building.

### **FROM THE WEST**

#### **Via Interstate Route 279 North and US Routes 22/30 East:**

Follow to/through the Fort Pitt Tunnels. Cross the Fort Pitt Bridge and exit at the Liberty Avenue Exit (Exit 6B). Proceed along Liberty Avenue 4.4 miles to its termination at Centre Avenue. Turn left onto Centre Avenue (which ultimately becomes Penn Circle South) and proceed 0.7 mile to 5989 Penn Circle South, a 1½ story yellow brick building, on the left. Park in the parking lot in front of (adjacent to) the building. Enter the entrance under the PIPS sign. The entrance to PIPS is to the right, after the entrance into the building.

### **OUR LOCATION**

THE PITTSBURGH INSTITUTE OF PLASTIC SURGERY (PIPS) is located in the East Side area of Pittsburgh, where the East Liberty and Shadyside areas of Pittsburgh meet. Recently, the East Side area of Pittsburgh has been the focus of considerable retail and related development and is now home to a number of upscale businesses. Additionally, our neighborhood is home to a number of talented artists, galleries, antique shops and the like. Neighboring areas include Highland Park, home to the Pittsburgh Zoo and PPG Aquarium; Shadyside, known for beautiful homes, diverse shops and popular restaurants; Bloomfield, known as “Pittsburgh’s Little Italy” (and also home to popular restaurants); and Oakland, home to Pittsburgh’s finest and best known educational and cultural institutions. THE PITTSBURGH INSTITUTE OF PLASTIC SURGERY (PIPS) occupies the middle suite of a 1½ story yellow brick building at 5989 Penn Circle South. Our co-tenants are Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Greater Pittsburgh, a non-profit which, as its name suggests, provides mentors to compromised children, and Ross Development Company, a successful developer of both commercial and residential real estate in Pittsburgh and elsewhere. The entrance to our parking lot sits directly opposite Borders Book Store, one of many diverse tenants (another one of which is Pittsburgh’s only Whole Foods Supermarket) of “Eastside”, a new retail development which occupies several blocks of Penn Circle South.
